Discover exciting new modern British and contemporary art galleries at London Art Fair. Gemma Hickman's (pictured left) six year old bo-lee gallery has a diverse clutch of young British artists who rework historic artworks or include taxidermy, (such as *Catcher of the Night* by Rachel Ann Stevenson (pictured left)). See Bobbie Russon's ambiguous, innocent, yet edgy portraits or Cathy Lewis's unnerveing lifelike sculptures. Omer Troche (pictured above) is the bright newcomer, having opened his Playfair gallery in February. Troche has surprising gems, including a Dariusz Hinz spot painting, Anthony Caro desert bronze and a charming Graham Sutherland surrealist landscape. ■
